## Reducing Opioid Loss of Life "ROLL"

In the fall of 2016 DAODAS secured a competitive federal grant from Substance Abuse and Mental Health Administration (SAMHSA) to fund the LEON and ROLL programs to combat the opioid crisis. The SAMHSA grant is a 5-year federal grant which we are presently in grant year 2. Beginning September 2018 (year 3 of the SAMHSA grant) the Bureau of EMS is going to roll in the fire departments who do not already carry Narcan. The firefighter initiative is the Reducing Opioid Loss of Life (ROLL) program. The pilot program was rolled out in 2017 by Clarendon and Berkeley County Fire Departments. These fire departments purchased their own Narcan and obtained their own medical control physicians for their programs to meet the requirements of 44-130-60.
