

2019 BBQ Competition Official Rules



Date: June 28, 2019

Location: Lincoln Street Set Up Date & Time: 7:00 am Space Size: 12 x 12 Team Limits: 25 Rules & Requirements: Cooking Participants must be a Current or Retired Firefighter.

Equipment:

Cooker Able to heat and store 5 gallons of Water. Adequate A septic techniques. All cooking supplies you may need. Cooking gloves. Tent's Pop Ups allowed – common sense will be used. Meat Thermometer

Definition of a Team:

A team consist of One Chief Cook whom must fit the requirements of Current or Retired firefighter and no more than three assistants.

NO PROFESSIONAL TEAMS ALLOWED!

If found you have a professional on your team, you will be disqualified and not eligible for a prize.

Categories:

Pork – must be able to cook a minimum of 16 Boston butts. (2 cases of meat)

Rules:

All meat will be provided to the competitors Raw Head Cook meeting will be at 7:30 am on June 28th Cooks are to prepare and cook barbecue in a sanitary manner as possible. Cooking conditions are subject to inspection by Fire – Rescue Staff, DHEC & Local Fire Marshal. Conditions found to be unsanitary will be grounds for disqualification from this cook-off.

All teams must have at least ONE fire extinguisher on site.

Contestant's space will be available for each team. There is no electricity available at these spots. All cooking facilities, rigs, props or show articles must fit within your team's contest space.

Judging:

Saturday June 28th @ 5:00 pm Competitors must turn in meat between 4:45 – 4:55 pm There will be a blind judging, you will receive a serving tray. This is a BBQ meat competition not a sauce competition. When you turn in you meat, if you would like to provide a homemade sauce on the side we welcome that.

There will be a peoples choice award. The general public will be given the opportunity to vote for there favorite team. Each team will have a fire boot to collect, the voting tickets. Votes will be tallied by Fire – Rescue Staff.

Sampling:

Wristbands will be sold to the general public for \$10.00 per band. Each ticket will purchase a 2-ounce sample of BBQ. When wrist bands are purchased, 1 Voting ticket per band sold will be given out. Each BBQ Participant will have a Boot for the people to drop their ticket in their favorite sample.
