Scott Feather currently serves as a Battalion Chief in charge of fire training for Colleton County Fire-Rescue. Chief Feather joined the fire service in 1992 as a volunteer firefighter in Tennessee and subsequently served in the United States Air Force (1993-2001) providing aircraft rescue firefighting and structural response.
